

Assembly/operating instructions for linovum ceiling light spot serie TAVIRA

1. Intended use

This product is for lighting purposes only and: - may only be installed indoors - only be operated in dry rooms, i.e. not in damp rooms or rooms where there is a risk of dirt and in the area of high humidity - must not be exposed to strong mechanical loads or heavy soiling - may not be operated after damp or dirty storage until after a condition check - may not be changed or modified, otherwise the operating permit and conformity will expire with immediate effect! It is not allowed to remove the type plate.

▲ If the aforementioned points are not observed, a short circuit or electric shock may occur! **There is danger to life!**

2. General safety instructions

▲ For safe handling of the product, the user must have read and understood the installation/operating instructions completely before using the device for the first time.

▲ The product may only be used if it is alright. If the device or parts of it are defective, it must be repaired by a qualified electrician.

▲ Only use lamps/light sources approved by the manufacturer. The max. lamp wattage in watts is not allowed to be exceeded.

▲ This product is not a toy and is not allowed to be stored or used within the reach of children.

▲ Safe operation of the product is only guaranteed if these instructions are followed. Therefore, keep these assembly/operating instructions.

Linovum GmbH accepts no liability if the instructions given here are not followed or the lamp is subjected to improper use.

3. Assembly & configuration

▲ **Caution:** The connecting cable must be disconnected from the power supply before starting work (switch off the main switch/fuse)! Only use parts which are supplied with the product or which are clearly marked as equipment! Otherwise the product may not be sufficiently safe!

3.1 Assembly location

The product may only be installed on a stable, tilt-resistant and level surface. Do not cover the product! Fire hazard!

▲ Components of the luminaire and especially the lamps/lamps, especially in the case of halogen lamps/lamps, become hot during operation. Keep a sufficient distance (0.5 m) from easily flammable objects (e.g. curtains, drapes, etc.) and flammable materials (ignition temperature <250°C)!

4. Operation, bulb replacement, faults & disorders

▲ **Caution:** Disconnect the power supply before replacing lamps/lamps (unplug the Euro plug before replacing the lamps)! Halogen lamps/light sources become very hot during operation - risk of burns! Therefore, do not touch the protective glass or the reflector! Allow to cool down before replacing! Do not cover! Covering with (e.g. towel) is a fire hazard! Luminaires with protective cover may only be operated with complete protective cover!

▲ Never look directly into the light source!

What to do in case of error?

In case of an error, the device must be switched off immediately. The product may only be operated if it works correctly.

This is the case if:

1. there is visible damage, 2. the product is not working correctly, 3. there is smoke, steam, or audible crackling noises, 4. overheating can be detected

▲ **Caution:** There is a danger to life - repairs to the product or work on parts carrying mains voltage may only be carried out by qualified electricians.

Avoidance of disturbances and fire hazards:

The product must not be covered under any circumstances. Air circulation must be guaranteed. Nothing must be attached or hung on the product, especially no decoration.

5. Cleaning & care instructions

The product may only be wiped dry or carefully with a slightly damp and lint-free cloth. The product is not allowed to be removed for this purpose. Do not use abrasive or sharp objects or aggressive cleaning agents. Do not use solvents.

Can only be used indoors

- Note:** The assembly steps are identical for all models. Only the number of light heads differs.
1. Disconnect the connecting cable from the power supply, do not plug in the Euro plug before installation!
 2. Use part 1 (rod with lights & connection cable) and lead the cable through rod 2. Screw part 1 and 2 together by thread. (Fig. 1)
 3. Repeat this step with part 3. (Fig. 2)
 4. Now guide the cable through the stand and screw the three rods to the stand. (Fig. 3)
 5. Connect the connecting cable (Euro plug with foot switch) with the supply cable of the luminaire (L & N per cable connector). (Fig. 4)
 6. Stick the protective plate onto the underside of the luminaire. To do this, remove the protective film and position the adhesive surface on the luminaire. (Fig. 5)
 7. Unscrew the rings on the lamp head including the frosted glass cover.
 8. Insert & turn the GU10 light bulb into the socket and tighten the previously removed luminaire head rings.
 9. Repeat steps 7 and 8 according to the respective number of light heads.
 10. Connect the Euro plug to a socket. If the lamps do not light up immediately, press the foot switch.
 11. The product is now ready for use.
