

Safety instructions for goal downsizers (goal reducers)



Important safety instructions for your sports equipment

To ensure the enjoyment of the game and the safety of all involved, please strictly observe the following points:

Stability & Construction

Tilt protection:

All movable gates must be permanently secured against tipping over in accordance with EN 16579:2018 (e.g. by ground anchors or counterweights).

Subsoil:

Only place the gate on a level, load-bearing surface.

Regular inspection:

Check all screw connections and locking elements for tightness before each game.

Using the goal

No climbing:

Never climb, hang, or swing on the goal frame or nets. There is an acute risk of injury from tipping over or material breakage.

Misuse:

The goal is designed exclusively for football (or the intended ball sport).

Using the goal downsizer (goal reducer)

Handling:

Do not pull, hang, or swing the goal downsizer. The structure is not designed to bear additional weight.

Weather:

The goal downsizer must not be used outdoors in moderate winds. The increased surface area (sail effect) increases the risk of the goal tipping over.

Disassembly:

When not in use or in case of an approaching storm, the gate reducer should be dismantled and stored safely.

Duty of supervision

Never leave children unattended while playing with or around the goals.

Actively inform all users of these safety rules before first use.
